




## VILLAGE OF CLINTON WILDFIRE

### EVACUATION ORDER RESCIND

Mayor Jim Rivett from the Village of Clinton has been advised that the imminent risk of danger to life and properties in your area has diminished at this time.

I HEREBY DECLARE the Evacuation Order issued on July 29, 2017 at 1630 hrs, pursuant to Section. 5.4 of TNRD Local Authority Emergency Program Bylaw No. 2017, is therefore rescinded, **effective today, Tuesday, August 15, 2017 at 1600 hours**, for the area on the attached map. The Evacuation Alert remains in effect. An Evacuation Order may need to be reissued if the risk of danger to life and property should again warrant such action.

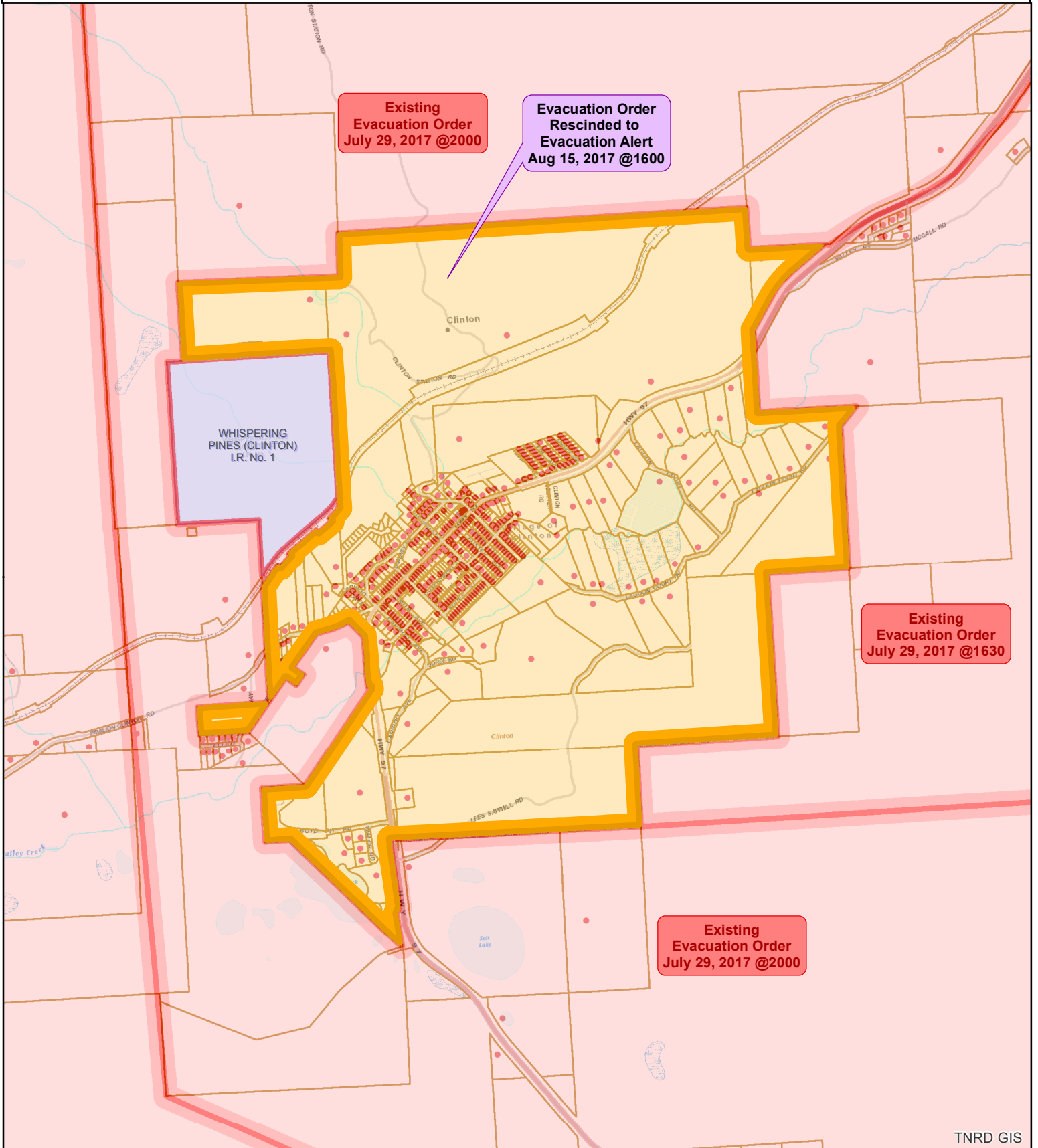

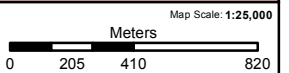
