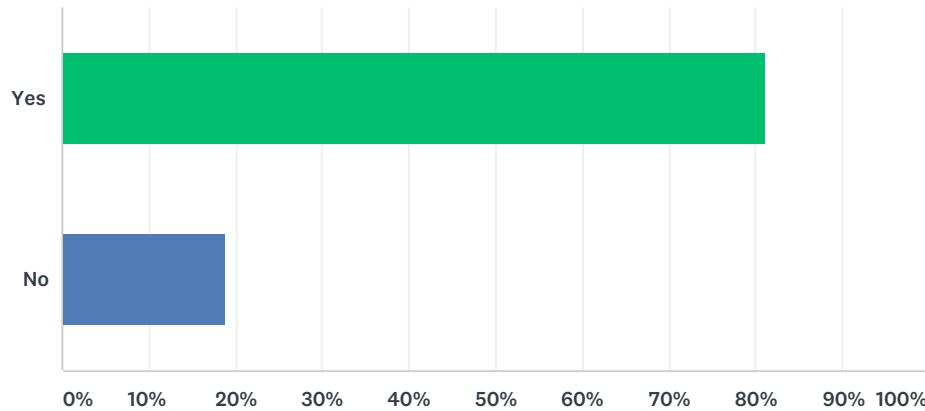


Q1 Do you live in Clinton?

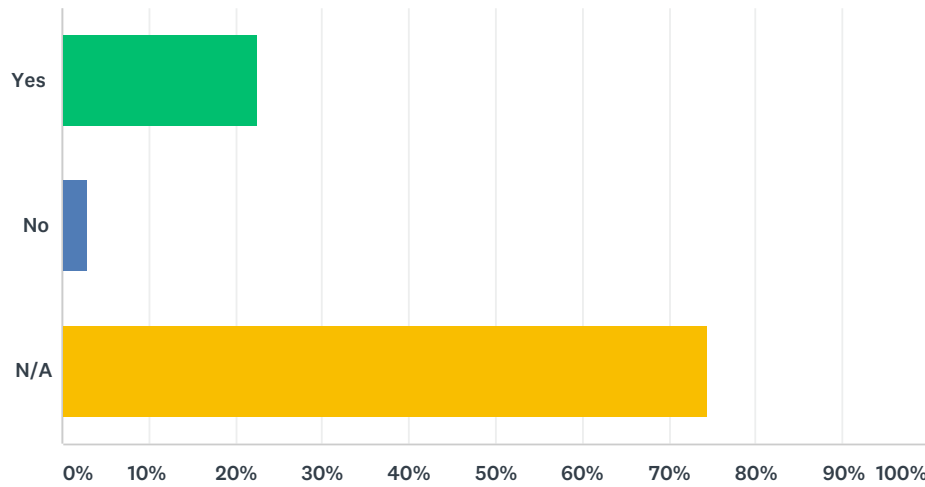

Q2 If you are not a resident of Clinton, do you live within a 50 km radius?

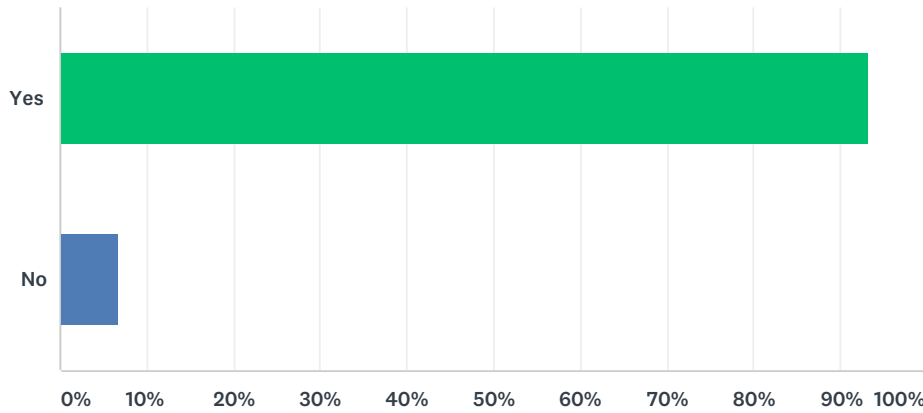

Q3 Do you know anyone that has used medical or other Cannabis?

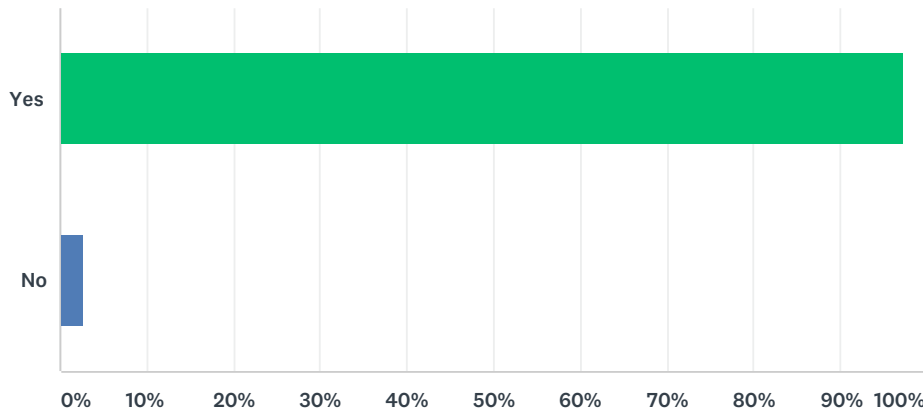

Q4 Are you aware of the healing and pain reduction benefits of Cannabis?

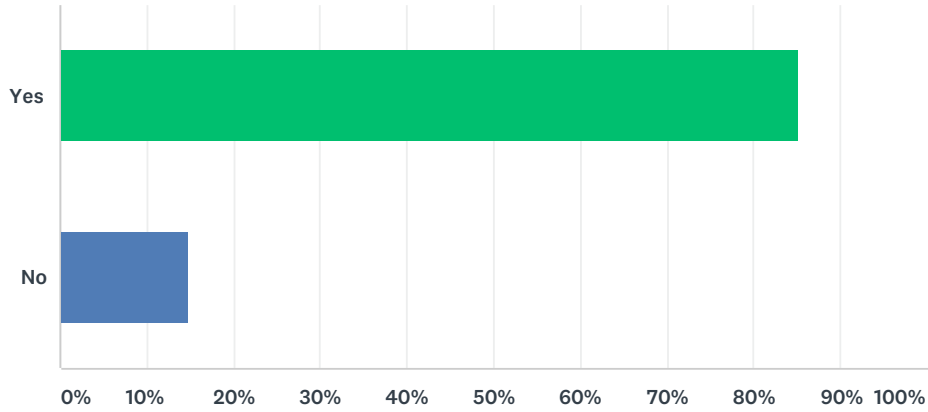

Q5 Do you believe more education is necessary to understand the benefits of Cannabis?

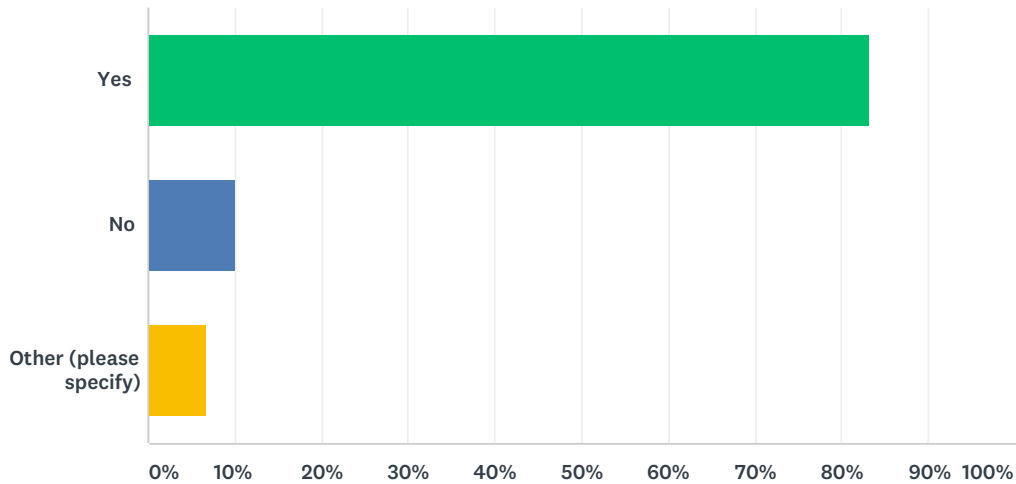

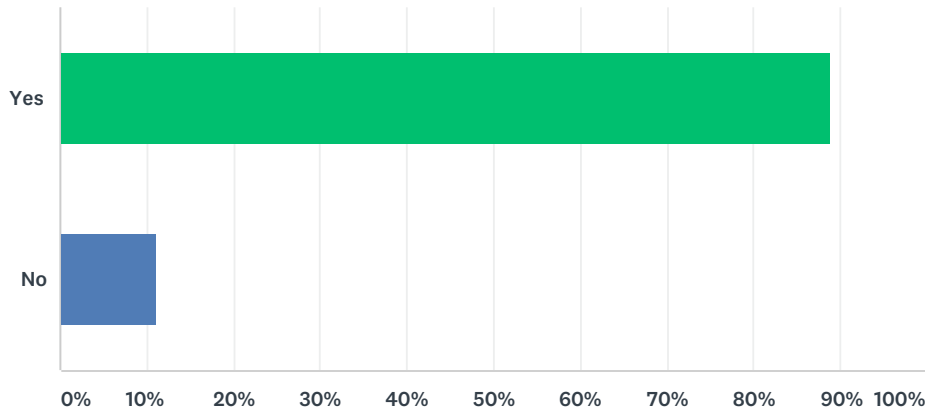

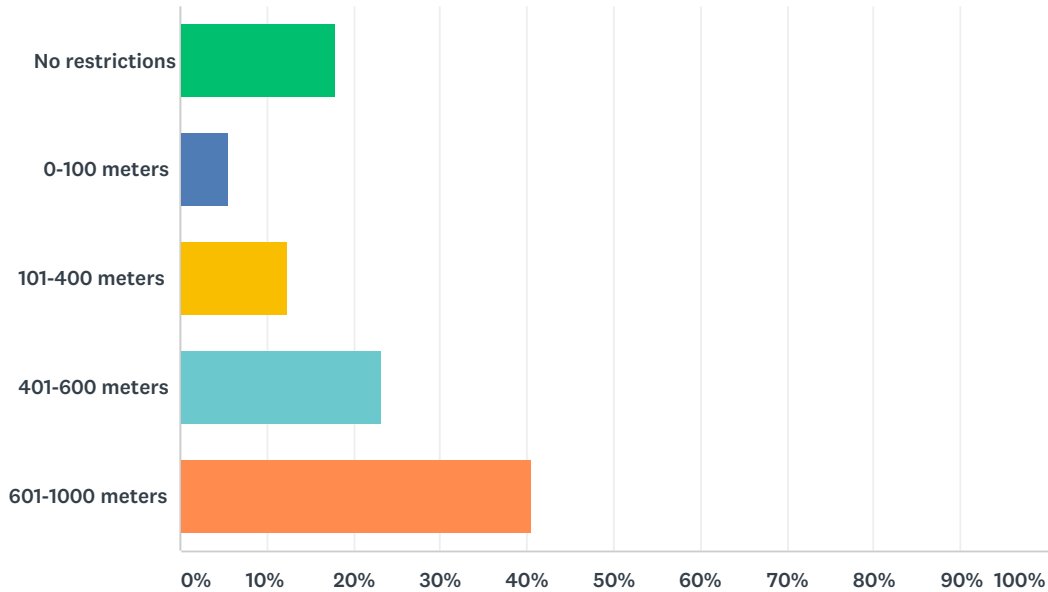

Q8 If we had a store in Clinton, should there be restrictions on how far from a school it is located? If so, what distance is acceptable?

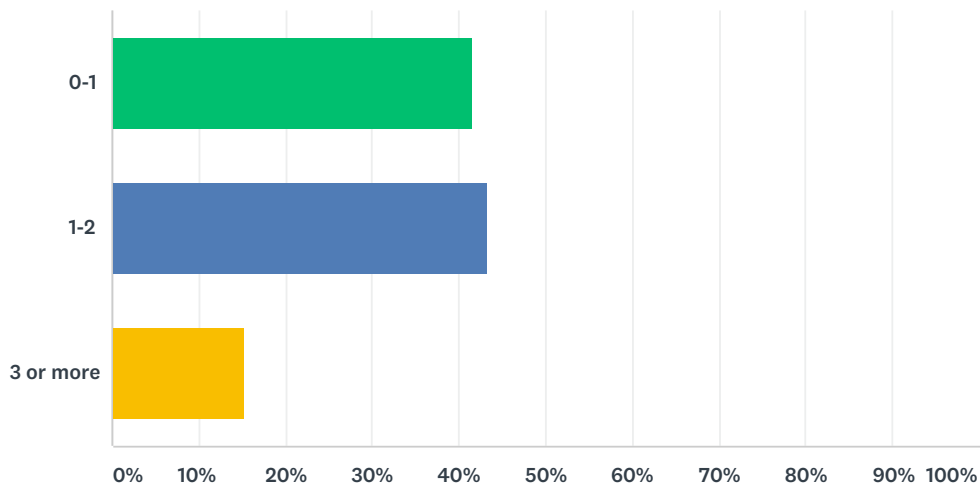

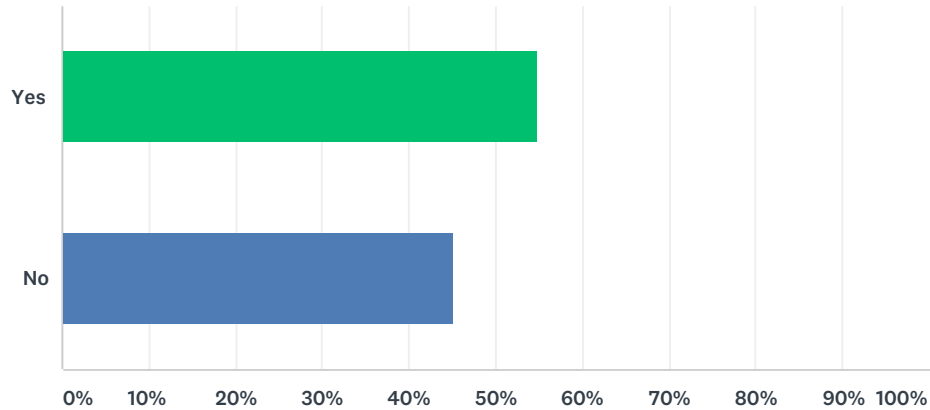

Q10 Should number of allowed stores be population based?

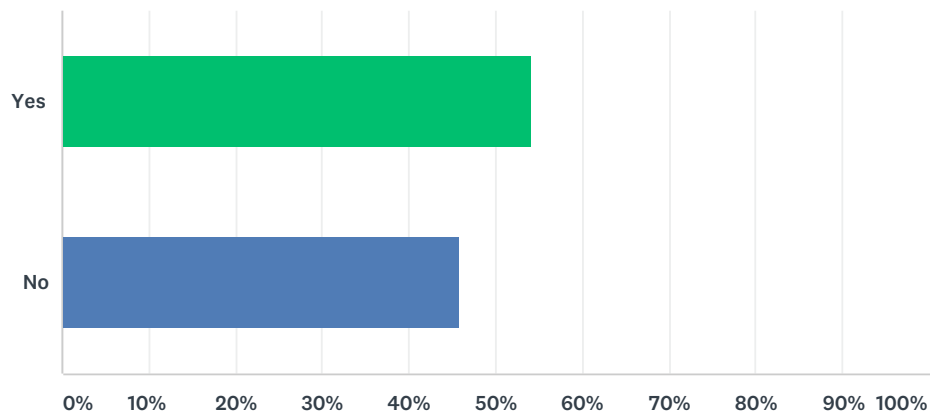

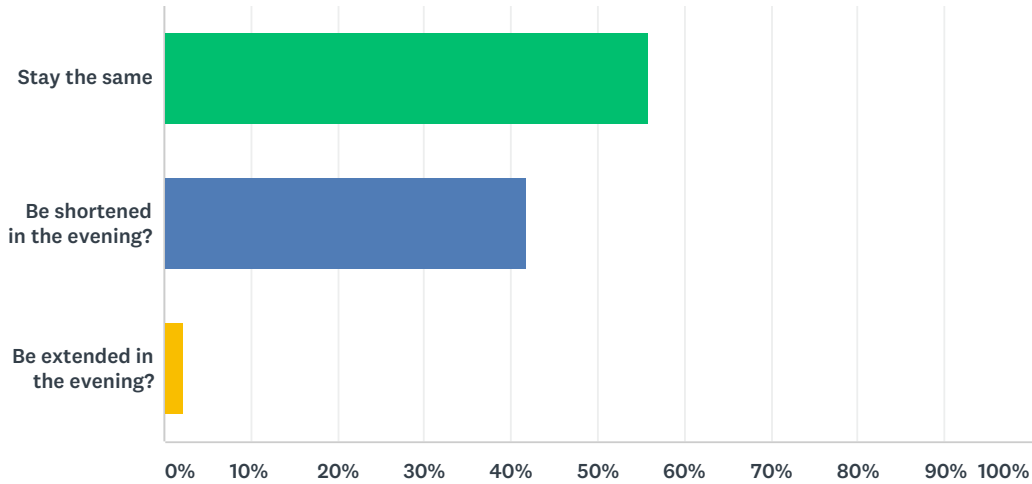

Q12 The current operating hours for a retail store are 9:00 am - 11:00 pm. Should these hours:

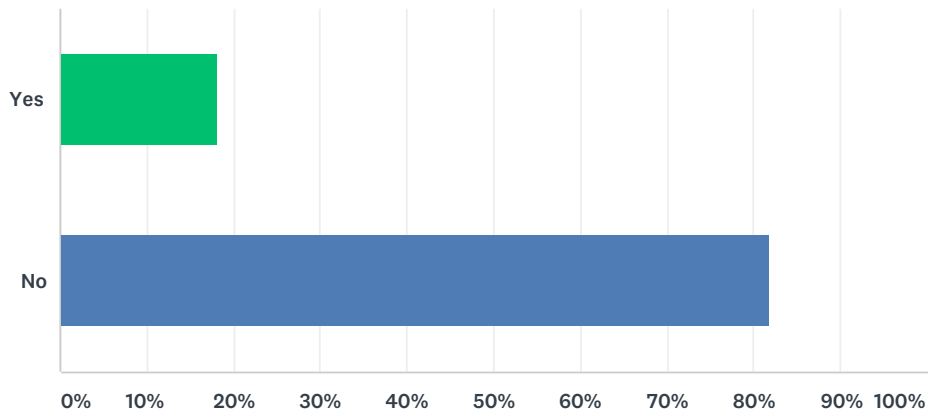
