## BYLAW NO. 513, 2014

### A BYLAW TO AMEND "VILLAGE OF CLINTON SEWER REGULATION BYLAW NO. 443, 2006"

---

**WHEREAS** The Village of Clinton wishes to amend Bylaw No. 443, 2006

**NOW THEREFORE:** the Council of the Village of Clinton, in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

#### 1. CITATION

This Bylaw may be cited as "Village of Clinton Sewer Regulation Bylaw No. 443, 2006 Amendment Bylaw No. 513, 2014".

This Bylaw will be effective as of December 31, 2014 along with the changes to the Fees and Charges Bylaw.

#### 2. AMENDMENTS

##### 1. Section 7 Rates and Charges be amended to exclude the following:

**Section 7.4** A penalty of 10% (ten percent) shall be imposed upon the balance of outstanding utilities that is unpaid after September 30<sup>th</sup> of the billing year

**Section 7.5** For any water service turned on after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, the user account will be billed for the amount equal to the annual rate for the number of days remaining in the year.

**Section 7.6** For any water service turned off after the 1<sup>st</sup> of January, the user account will be credited for an amount to the annual rate prorated for the number of days remaining in the year.


##### 2. Section 7 Rates and Charges will be replaced with the following:


**Section 7.4** For any water service user requesting a suspension of service will be required to make the full annual payment and upon completion of a suspension of service application the user will receive a 50% rebate on the amount owing during the suspension of service as long as the water service billing is in good standing.

**Section 7.5** Rebate will be credited to the owner's water service account prior to December 31<sup>st</sup> of the service year

**Section 7.7 and Section 7.8 will be renumbered to be 7.6 and 7.7 respectively in order to maintain continuity with the changes in this Bylaw.**
