

Press Release March 17, 2020

Updated information directly from the Thompson-Nicola Regional District:

Please be informed that effective 5:00 pm tonight - March 16th, we will be shutting down all library services. We have asked that all staff continue to work unless they are ill or need to care for a family member at home.

We will also close all community halls that are operated by the TNRD and are advising all other community halls which are operated by separate societies that they should consider doing the same.

We are meeting daily regarding our response to the COVID 19 crisis and will keep you informed as changes to our operation unfold. This message will be sent out to all media outlets and CAOs in the Regional District.

Effective Immediately – The Village of Clinton will close the following facilities to the public: 47 Mile Arena, the Curling Rink and Memorial Hall.

We will be monitoring the Provincial and Interior Health directives on COVID-19 and a decision on whether to re-open the Memorial Hall to the public will be made on March 31, 2020.

We are encouraging our residents not to visit the office unless it's absolutely necessary. If you wish to make a payment, you are encouraged to contact your financial institution to set up Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) or you can mail us a cheque.

We are taking these steps as a precaution to ensure the health and safety of our residents.
