

**THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF CLINTON
FEES & CHARGES BYLAW No. 480, 2010**

A Bylaw to establish and amend various fees and charges imposed by the Municipality

WHEREAS Provincial statutes provide authority for Municipalities to establish various fees and charges and it is deemed desirable and expedient to establish these fees and charges in one bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Clinton in open meeting assembled hereby **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

The Village of Clinton hereby amends the fees for service as specified in Schedules "A" to "F" in this bylaw:

- a) Schedule "A" - Miscellaneous Fees and Charges
- b) Schedule "B" - animal Licence and Impoundment Fines
- c) Schedule "C" - Cemetery Fees
- d) Schedule "D" - Rental Fees for Recreational Facilities and Equipment
- e) Schedule "E" - Water Rates 2010-2013
- f) Schedule "F" - Sewer Rates 2010-2013

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Village of Clinton Fees & Charges Bylaw No. 480, 2010".

Fees & Charges Bylaw 463, 2010 and Amendment Bylaw No. 478, 2110 is hereby repealed in their entirety.





- (C) No development fees will be refunded if the application has been submitted to Council
- (D) Subdivision fees are non-refundable
- (E) Board of Variance Fees for appeals withdrawn prior to the preparation of the appeal for advertising and circulation to staff and Board of Variance are eligible for a \$50.00 refund

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SCHEDULE "D"

RENTAL FEE SCHEDULE FOR VILLAGE FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

MEMORIAL HALL:

All Groups (meetings, bingos, flea markets, weddings, dances, receptions, funerals, etc.):

- \$25.00 per hour for hall only
- \$35.00 per hour for hall and kitchen
- \$40.00 per hour for hall and bar
- \$50.00 per hour for hall, kitchen and bar
- \$25.00 per day for Sound System for Memorial Hall
- \$250 clean-up and security deposit required
- \$75 setup tables and chairs, diagram to be supplied by renter
- \$2 million liability insurance naming Village of Clinton as additional insured for all events where alcoholic beverages are being served.

A non-refundable booking fee of \$20 per date will be required to confirm the booking. This booking fee will be applied to the rental rate.

Chairs, tables, steam table, dishes and cutlery are not allowed out of the Hall.

EQUIPMENT RENTAL:

Rental chairs, tables and other equipment are to be inspected and counted by Village staff when they go out and when they are returned.

- Chairs \$0.50 each per day + \$150 security deposit
- Tables \$2.00 each per day + \$150 security deposit
- Coffee Urns \$2.50 per day + \$150 security deposit
- Grill \$20.00 per day + \$250 security deposit for Reg Conn Park only
- Projector \$20.00 per day
- Minimum charge \$10.00 on all equipment

VILLAGE OFFICE:

- Meeting room rental \$30.00 first two hours, \$5.00 each additional hour (no charge for local non-profit)
- Coffee for meetings \$10.00 per pot

ARENA RENTAL

- \$60.00 per hour (1 hour min) (max. \$600 per day) for tournaments, private parties, trade shows, etc.
- \$50.00 per hour for adult hockey practices (1 hour min)
- \$25.00 per hour for Minor hockey practices, figure skating practices and private skating/birthday parties for children under 13 yrs (1 hr min)
- \$250.00 clean-up and security deposit required
- \$2.00 – public skating per person (under 6 yrs free)
- \$5.00 – family rate for public skating (parents/grandparents & kids) per day
- \$50.00 – family rate for season pass
- \$20.00 – single rate for season pass

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ELLIOTT PARK – REG CONN PARK RENTAL (for water/power and/or concession/band shell)

- \$50 per day per event for area residents (local minor sports excepted)
- \$200.00 per day per event for non-residents
- \$250 clean-up and security deposit

(residents are defined as those living within the fire protection boundary or by staff discretion according to individual's contribution to the community)
