

BYLAW NO. 509, 2014

A BYLAW TO AMEND "VILLAGE OF CLINTON ZONING BYLAW NO. 439, 2007"

WHEREAS The Federal Government has adopted the Marihuana for Medical

Purposes Regulations (MMPR);

AND WHEREAS The Village of Clinton wishes to regulate the location of the Medical

Marihuana operations within the Village of Clinton;

AND WHEREAS the zoning amendment conforms to the Village of Clinton Official

Community Plan (OCP)

AND WHEREAS the Village of Clinton Zoning Bylaw No. 439, 2007 requires some number

changes to Sections 13 & 14 of the Bylaw

AND WHEREAS the zoning for two publicly operated facilities are not zoned according to

their current use therefore the Village of Clinton requires the Museum

and the Eco Depot properties be re-zoned.

NOW THEREFORE: the Council of the Village of Clinton, in open meeting assembled enacts as

follows:

1. CITATION

This Bylaw may be cited as "Village of Clinton Zoning Bylaw No. 439, 2007 Amendment Bylaw No. 509, 2014".

2. AMENDMENTS

1. Schedule A Definitions be amended to include:

<u>MEDICAL MARIHUANA GROW OPERATION</u> – means the cultivation, growth, processing, storage or distribution of marihuana for medical purposes as lawfully permitted and authorized under the *Marihuana for Medical Purposes Regulations*.

<u>RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT LABORATORY</u> – means a laboratory and associated offices for the development and/or testing of mechanical devices, materials and non-biohazard chemical products.

2. SECTION 13 - I-1 LIGHT INDUSTRIAL

Section 13 – I-1 Light Industrial requires an amendment to the current numbering system in this section. The following changes will be made:

- a. Regulations will be changed from 13.2 to Regulations 13.3
- b. Conditions of Use will be changed from 13.3 to Conditions of Use 13.4
- c. Other Regulations will be changed from 13.4 to Other Regulations 13.5

13.2 Add the following to Permitted Uses:

- r. Medical Marihuana Grow Operations
- s. Research and Development Laboratory

13.4 Add the following to Condition of Use:

- d. Medical Marihuana Grow Operation will be subject to the following restrictions within the I-1 Light Industrial zone:
 - ii. A minimum parcel size of 5 acres
 - iii. A minimum set back of 50 metres from all parcel lines
 - iv. Health Canada approval

3. SECTION 14 - I-2 HEAVY INDUSTRIAL

Section 14 - I - 1 Light Industrial requires an amendment to the current numbering system in this section. The following changes will be made:

- a. Other Regulations will be changed from 14.3 to Other Regulations 14.4
- 14.3 Add the following to Conditions of Use:
 - h. Medical Marihuana Grow Operation will be subject to the following restrictions within the I-2 Heavy Industrial zone:
 - i. A minimum parcel size of 5 acres
 - ii. A minimum set back of 50 metres from all parcel lines
 - iii. Health Canada approval

4. SECTION 15 - PUBLIC USE

- a. That Lot A Plan KAP34655 LLD Clinton Townsite PID 002-940-540(commonly known as the Clinton Museum property) zoning be changed from C-1 Commercial to P-1 Public Use
- b. That Lot 1, Plan KAP19385 District Lot 1060 LLD, Except Plan KAP58096 PID 009-620-222, (commonly known as the Thompson-Nicola Regional District Eco Depot)zoning be changed from I-1 to P-1 and adding Regional Government recycling/transfer station/eco-depot to Section 15.1 Permitted Use.
