Attended the TNRD meeting:

- (1) Cordelio has applied to investigate the feasibility of developing a wind power project on crown land 25kn northwest of Clinton and east of Big Bar.
- (2) Gold Country service bylaw to be taken to a third reading to terminate. If it's passed, then it will be going to the inspector of municipalities for approval before being adopted. This would leave Cache Creek as the only member left and may be in a position to take on the entire cost of running Gold Country.
- (3) The 911 primary contract with the regional district of Central Okanagan is being extended for another year for a cost of \$325, 702. This is the TNRD portion of the costs which includes 7 other regional districts. With the next generation 911 service introduced over the next few years, the next few years, the regional district cannot quote costs beyond 1 year.
